

The Region 3A Northeast Public Health Coalition consists of fourteen communities in northeastern Massachusetts. The Coalition requires the assistance of part-time, contract health professionals to serve on an as-needed basis under its Emergency Preparedness, MDPH contract. Said professionals will assist in completing health inspections, public health planning and reporting, and in various clinical and other services. Contractors may be called for during regular staff vacations, to assist during public health emergencies, or to supplement staffing as needed. The number of contracts to be offered will depend on need and the availability of MDPH funds. Health Inspector

Under the general direction of one or more Region 3A municipal Director of Public Health/Health Agent(s), the contractor will perform field inspections, investigate complaints and conduct plan reviews for compliance with the all applicable State Codes. Minimum qualifications include a demonstrated knowledge of applicable codes and appropriate certifications (i.e. Title 5 Soil Evaluator, Certified Food Safety Manager, Lead Determinator, Certified Pool Operator). Previous experience in the contracted inspections is required. Inspectors are paid either a flat rate of \$25.00 per inspection or at another rate negotiated by the Region 3A community(ies) for which the work is to be performed.

Public Health Nurse

Under the general direction of one or more Region 3A municipal Director(s) of Public Health/Health Agent(s), the contractor will perform clinical work in the field of public health. Minimum qualifications include a thorough knowledge of clinical practice, disease prevention and treatment, and a demonstrated ability to communicate with the general public and clients. Those selected will all have Massachusetts Registered Nurse licenses. Nurses are paid at a rate of \$25.00 per hour or at another rate negotiated by the Region 3A community(ies) for which the work is to be performed

Public Health Emergency Planner

Under the general direction of one or more Region 3A municipal health-related official(s), prepares, reviews, and drafts public health emergency plans such as, but not limited to, Emergency Dispensing Site plans, Special Population plans, Continuity of Operations plans, Pandemic and Infectious Disease Response plans, and Medical Reserve Corp plans. Knowledge and experience drafting the types of plans listed will be preferred. Planners will be paid at a rate of \$25.00 per hour or at another rate negotiated by the particular Region 3A community(ies) for which the work is to be completed

The purpose of this posting is to develop a database of interested persons should the need for their use arise. Contracts will be with Region 3A Host Agency, International Institute of Greater Lawrence. Contractor payments will be guided by signed contract specifics and there is no guarantee of employment.
