The Middleton Board of Health held a Board Meeting on Wednesday, March 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2016 at the Flint Public Library Meeting Room, One South Main Street, Middleton, Massachusetts at 7:00 pm

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm. Chairman Ambrefe asked if there were any additions or changes to the Minutes of the January 6<sup>th</sup> 2016 meeting. Mr. Demeritt motioned to accept as written, Mr. Cryan seconded the motion and the Minutes were unanimously accepted by the Board.

**Massachusetts Association of Health Board Mass in Motion Grant 2016 Awarded** – Fullerton addressed the Board and said that, as discussed during the last meeting, he had applied for the 2016 Mass in Motion Grant. This application has been successful and a grant of \$7500 has been awarded to the Town of Middleton Health Department to be used towards a Healthy Aging (Public Health) Chapter in the Master Plan. The Master Plan Committee is reconvening to redo and update the Master Plan within in the near future. The Metropolitan Area planning Commission have been in contact expressing an interest in helping with this project. They are also involved in updating the Master Plan with the Master Plan Committee, so it may be great timing for both projects. \$4000 of the Grant has been received to date.

**Tobacco Prevention Review proposed revisions to Tobacco and Youth Access to Tobacco Regulations** - Chairperson Ambrefe addressed the Board and said the Board will review the regulations tonight and discuss further at the next meeting which will be on May 4<sup>th</sup> at Flint Public Library. The Board members agreed that the retailers who currently hold tobacco licenses will be invited to attend the above meeting.

The Board had a detailed discussion regarding revisions to be made to the regulations. The Board members agreed with the proposed revisions to the Tobacco and Youth Access to Tobacco Regulations.

Fullerton informed the Board members of recently properties new, proposed, or planned for redevelopment in the community, including details of the proposed Cumberland Farms Store currently scheduled to be completely rebuilt.

***Mr. Demeritt made a motion for adjournment. Mr. Cryan seconded the motion and all were in favor.  
The meeting was adjourned at 8:10 pm.***
